<u>Fishes</u>

For my fourth year I did a series called "Fishes". My inspiration for this series came from one painting called "Fish Girl" which I painted in my third year at the academy. The inspiration came from the background I had painted on the "Fish Girl". While I was painting the "Fish Girl" I was stuck on a background idea but then it came to me. I had always been interested in Chinese and Japanese art and culture and the use of koi fish. I remember seeing them a lot in works and was inspired to use them in my art. I did not use them in the classic watercolor painting technique but in an edge / pop art style.

"Fishes" was my idea to take a pattern and create it into one work that can work on its own and can be used in different techniques. In the future I would like to print my works on fabrics, accessories, clothing, and use for interior design. This piece was created to show that it can be used as a simple decorative silkscreen on a wall or broken into one piece paintings of various colors. My intention with the smaller pieces with one set of fish on them was to make a patch quilt blanket arrangement with the multicolored fish that can be continually grown with additional pieces. Every single fish was hand painted separately, using no stencil, making every fish unique and different in every work.


